

Fast Track Farmer Program Application

Central State University and the Coit Road Farmers Market are launching a produce beginning farmer program, for aspiring farmers interested in starting their own farm business. The program is designed to provide one growing season of support for beginning farmers with a hands-on demonstration farm site.

Program participants will receive one year of support in growing their farm business, including the following benefits at no charge:

- ❖ Over 60 hours of hands-on training from CSU Extension on all aspects (growing, planning and business skills) of operating a market produce farm.
- ❖ Access to a demonstration vegetable plot to apply skills learned and grow produce. Participants keep any income generated from farm sales at the Coit Road Farmers' Market.
- ❖ Support in developing a farm business plan, accessing USDA grant and loan programs and finding land at the end of the program.
- ❖ A certificate from Central State University Extension following completion of Year 1 of the program identifying curriculum and classes attended.

Program Requirements:

- ❖ Participation in on-farm classes in 2022, which will run from late March thru October.
 - ❖ Completion of class assignments, such as conducting soil tests, completing business plan, etc.
 - ❖ Commitment working in demonstration plots for an additional 2 - 4 hours/week during season for plot maintenance and marketing.
