Learn about edible native plants such as fruit and nut trees, berries, greens, herbs, mushrooms and flowers; environmental needs such as soil composition, sunlight vs shade and plant spacing; participate in landscape design plant seeds and starter plants; and develop educational graphics for the garden. There will be four learning and planting sessions Monday evenings April 24, May 8, May 22 and June 5 starting at 6:00PM at the Coit Road Farmers' Market. Participants will also receive plants for personal use.
